Criteria #3: Contribution to Research areas

- Applicant's study is an important piece of research in science education
- Applicant's study illustrates relevance to wider research community
- Applicant's study shows insight in research

- Applicant shows strong motivation to be a researcher
- Applicant shows strong competence in conducting science education research
- Applicant has teaching and research experience
